



**Call for Papers - Frontiers in Biorefining 2022**  
**Abstract deadline July 15, 2022**

The organizing committee of the **2022 Frontiers in Biorefining Conference** is soliciting abstracts for both oral and poster presentations. A limited number of slots are available for presentations emphasizing the latest developments on transformation of renewable carbon building blocks to fuels, chemicals and materials, enabling the integrated biorefinery concept. Topic areas include:

- Biorefining and the Circular Economy
- Biosynthesis and Deconstruction of Plant Cell Walls
- Integrated Conversion Technologies
- Polymers and Soft Materials
- Sustainable Aviation Fuels
- Lignin Valorization
- Carbohydrates Valorization
- Pushing the Frontiers of Biorefining

Frontiers in Biorefining focuses on the science underlying production of new bioproducts and biochemicals that will advance the concept of the integrated biorefinery. *Attendance will be limited* to facilitate open discussion of the latest topics in development of products from biorefinery process streams. **Graduate students:** the symposium includes flash talks and a poster competition for graduate students. Cash prizes will be awarded for the top three posters as determined by a committee of symposium attendees.
